Year 2 introduces more formal learning expectations - starting strong really does make a difference.

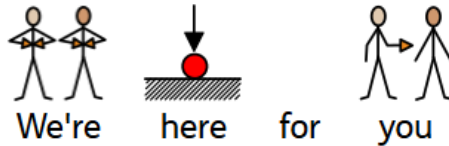


- Keep to a calm and consistent morning routine
