	Unit Overview	In this unit the children will learn to use the formal and informal greetings for hello and goodbye, for the right time of day. They will also learn to ask and answer questions about feelings.	Children will learn to use the French words for boy/ girl and to describe someone using their hair and eye colour. They will be able to use these words in sentences when describing people.	In this unit the children will learn to identify nouns by gender, number and meaning. They will use vocabulary for animals and their body parts.	In this unit the children will pronounce the name of sports accurately and use the verbs <i>jouer</i> and <i>faire</i> correctly. The children will be introduced to cognates and near cognates.

	Unit Overview	In this unit children will learn to use colour words and language to describe shape and size in French. In this unit the children will understand the French words for different types of houses and their rooms. They will also ask and answer questions using vocabulary about houses and rooms.

	Unit Overview		In this unit the children will be using numbers to 31, the days of the week, months of the year, seasons and dates in French as well as using language of birthdays.	In this unit the children will begin to recognise some regular verbs in the present tense and will know that some verbs do not follow regular patterns.	The children will learn to use future tense to plan a trip. They will use language of clothes and items that would be used on holidays.

In this unit the children will be able to describe routes around a town and share opinion about where to visit in the town.
