Regular attendance sets the tone for success, independence, and enjoyment of learning in Year 4.



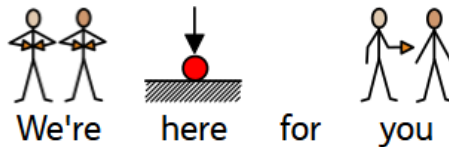
How you can help

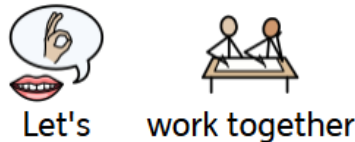
