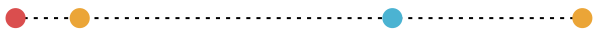

## 5 REASONS WHY WE NEED YOUR HELP

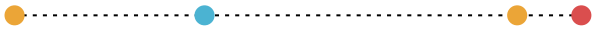


You are vital to the success of the school! FOBS are able to raise essential school funds, only because of YOUR continued support.

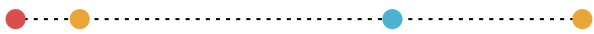


FOBS activities affect everyone within the school!

See the smiles on their faces and know that you have played a part in making school more memorable, pleasant and fun.

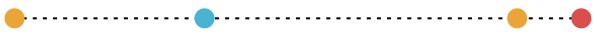


Make a difference! By volunteering to help the FOBS Team, you will be able to use whatever skills you have for a great cause.

## FOBS DURING 2017/2018
