- Build independence and resilience from the very start

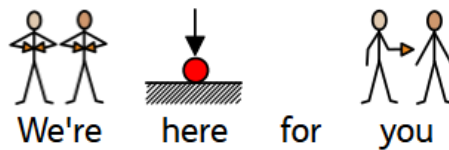


- Stick to a consistent bedtime and morning routine
