A consistent presence in school helps your child feel confident, connected, and capable.

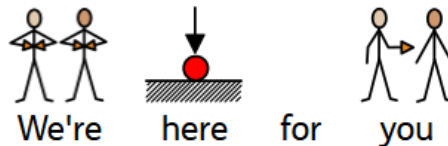


- Keep to a reliable morning and evening routine
