At Belmont Community Primary School, we monitor attendance throughout each term and at the end of every term, each child will bring home an Attendance report. The report will include the maximum number of school days for that term and the number of days your child has been absent from school. Your child's overall attendance percentage will also be included, and you will be able to see which category this attendance percentage falls into.

We look forward to working with all parents and carers ensuring that your child is at school more than 95% of the time and that they are on time each day.
