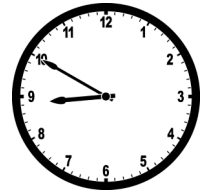




# ATTENDANCE

Children are expected to arrive between 8:45am and 8:55am each day.

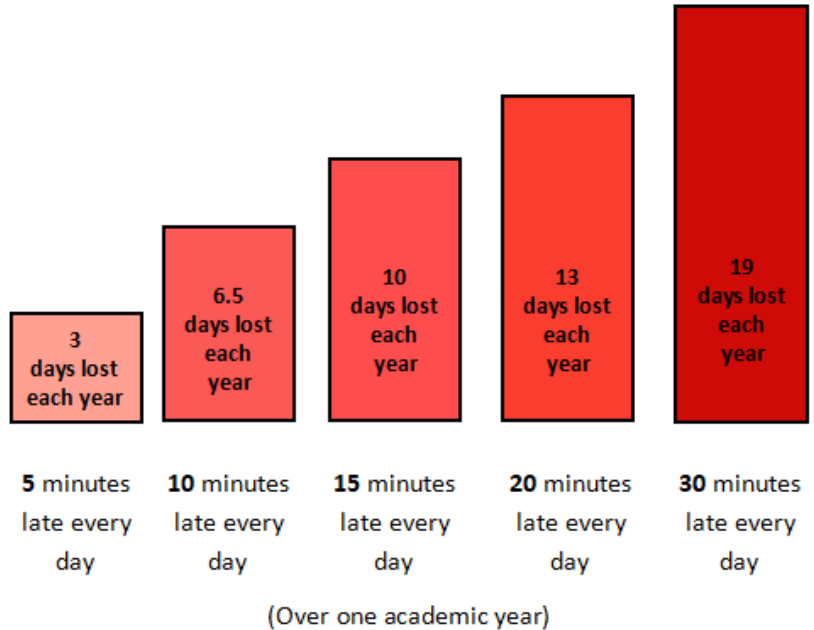
Children in EYFS and KS1 are expected to line up on the playground by 8:50am.

## Perfect Punctuality Pointers

- \* Remember the school gates open at 8:45am.
- \* Please arrive before 8:55am.
- \* Help your child become independent and get them their own alarm clock.
- \* Set the alarm clock 5 minutes fast.
- \* Get everything ready the night before - uniform, school shoes, water bottle, sun hat, suncream, PE kit and packed lunch.
- \* Don't allow the TV, computer games or phone before everyone is ready - if at all.
- \* Come even earlier and join us for Early Bird (from 7:45am) and Breakfast Club (from 8:20am). Open every weekday in the hall.
