Every school day counts BUT every minute is equally important.

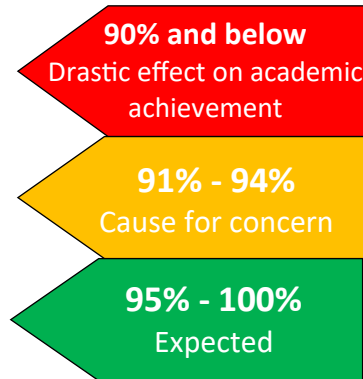


Children are expected to arrive between 8:45 and 8:55 each day.

Children in EYFS and KS1 are expected to line up on the playground by 8:50 and be taken in by their class teacher. The KS2 gate is opened at 8:45 when children can come into their classrooms.

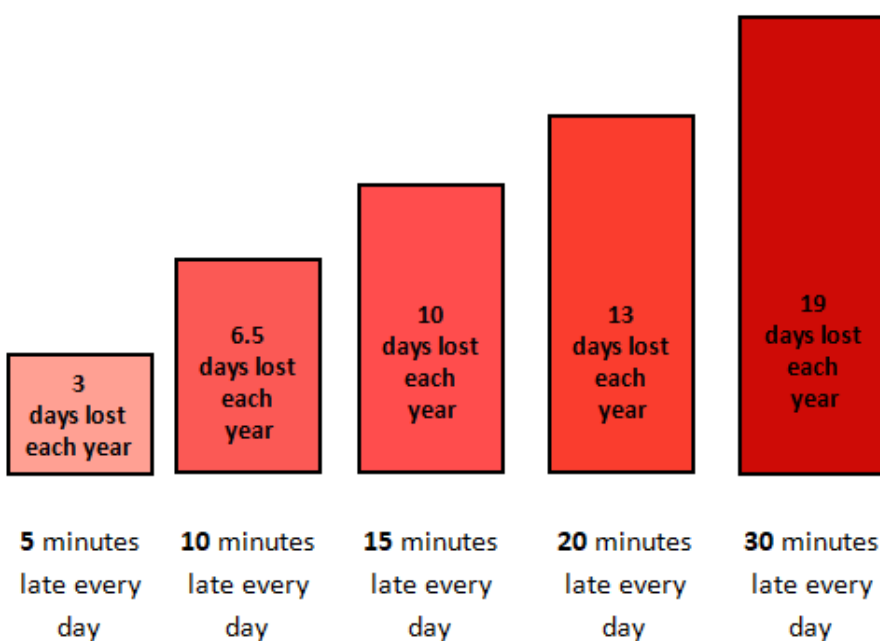
It is important to be on time as the first part of the school is used for morning learning activities, quiet reading and accelerated reader quiz taking.

### Perfect Punctuality Pointers

- \* Help your child become independent and get them their own alarm clock.
- \* Set the alarm clock 5 minutes fast.
- \* Get everything ready the night before - uniform, school shoes, PE kit and packed lunch.
- \* Don't allow the TV or computer games before everyone is ready - if at all.
- \* Come even earlier and join us for Early Bird (from 7:45) and Breakfast Club (from 8:20). Open every weekday in the hall.
