Important Safeguarding and Dismissal Information

To ensure the safety of all our children, we must maintain strict site security throughout the event:

Once the picnic has begun, all families must remain on the school premises. The gates will be locked for safeguarding reasons; we will not have a designated keyholder stationed at the gate to allow people to pop in and out.

End of the Day: At the conclusion of the celebrations, ALL children must return to their classrooms with their teachers to collect their belongings. Dismissal and collection will then take place at the normal time and from the usual areas.
